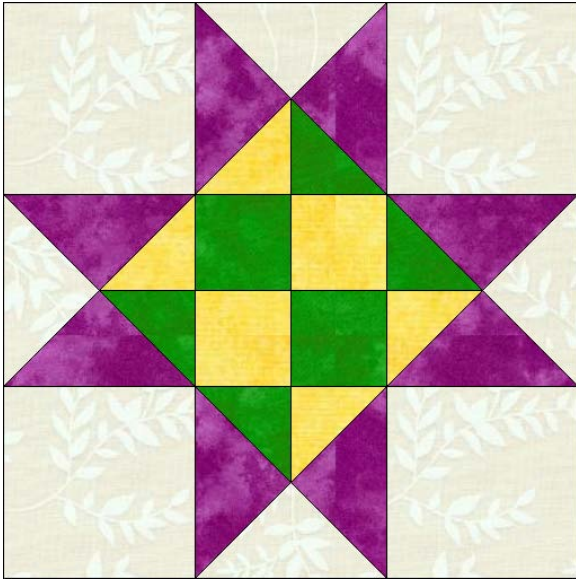


Country Farm – 12” finished/12-1/2 unfinished



Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1:

4 – 4-1/2” squares (A)

1 – 5-3/16” square – cut on the diagonal twice so you have 4 triangles. (B)

Fabric 4:

2 – 5-3/16” square – cut on the diagonal twice so you have 8 triangles. (C)

Fabric 6:

2 – 2-7/8” square – cut on the diagonal once so you have 4 triangles. (D)

2 – 2-1/2” squares. (E)

Fabric 8:

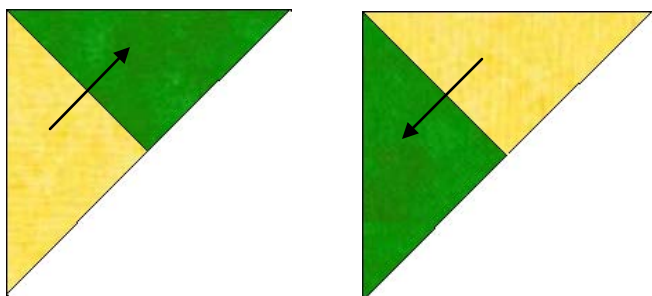
2 – 2-7/8” square – cut on the diagonal once so you have 4 triangles. (F)

2 – 2-1/2” squares. (G)

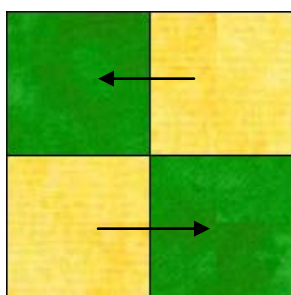
Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew the **Fabric 6 (D)** and **4 triangles (F)** together. Make 4.

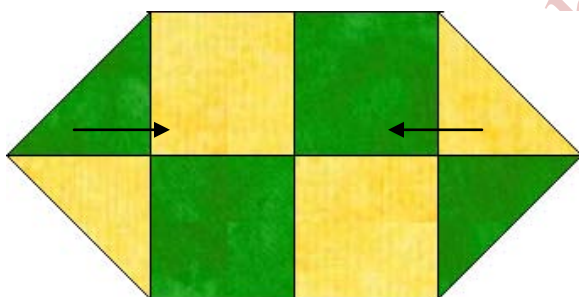
NOTE: Two are identical and two are reverse of the other two.



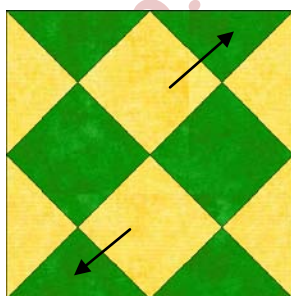
2. Using the squares of Fabrics 6 (E) and 8 (G), make a four patch.



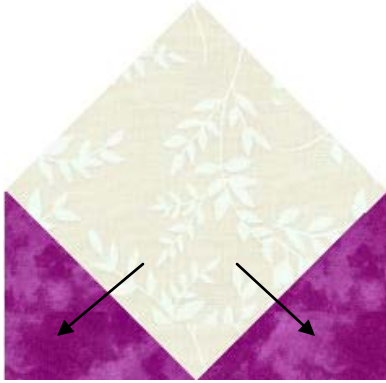
3. Sew a triangle unit from Step 1 to opposite ends of the four patch. Note where the placement of the fabrics!



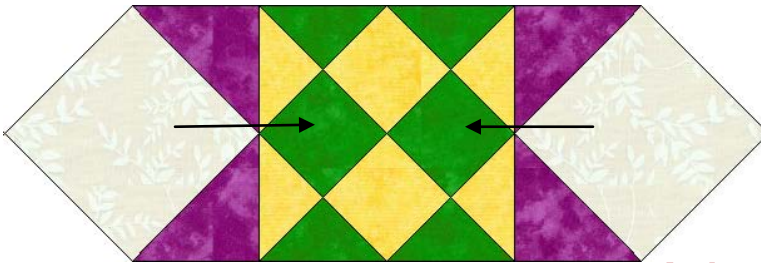
4. Sew the other two triangle units from Step 1 to the remaining sides of the four patch to create the center unit.



5. Sew the Fabric 4 triangles (C) to two sides of the Fabric 1 squares (A). Make 4.



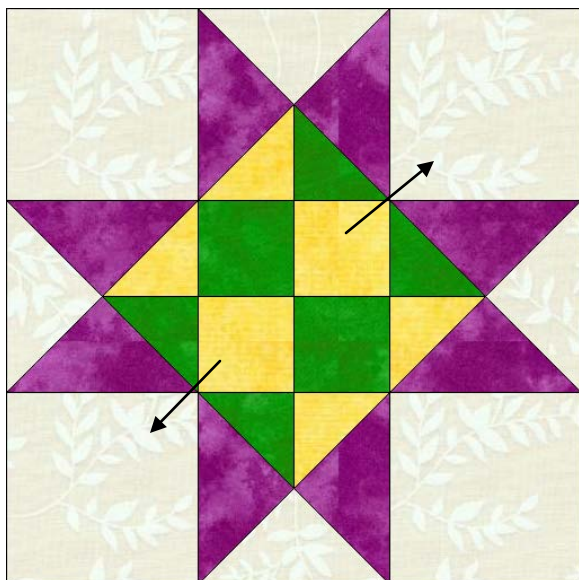
6. Add two of the units from Step 5 to the center unit.



7. Add Fabric 1 triangles (B) to each side of the two remaining units from Step 5.



8. Add these units to the center portion to complete the block.



Before putting it away:

- Mark the centers on all four sides.
- Label it as “Block #4”.
