

# About the Quilt:

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The quilt is easy! There are some half square triangles but other than those, it's squares and rectangles.

Blocks are 9" finished/9-1/2" unfinished.

Instructions will be given to make the top 45" x 63" without borders. Once you've made those blocks, if you wish to make your quilt larger, you can simply make more blocks. When I see you in October, I will show you the same top with multiple borders - 7 to be exact, one of which will be a pieced border.

IF YOU CHOOSE TO ADD THE BORDERS I USE:

- The top will then measure 67" x 85".
- You will need more fabric. Below you will find the fabric requirements for the plain quilt with no borders and fabric requirements for the quilt with the 7 borders.

Fabric Suggestions:

It's a mystery so be bold and brave! I am using a dark blue, a medium brown/tan and a medium green, as well as a background.

My suggestion is that you use a dark (where I use blue) (**Fabric 1**); 2 mediums (where I use brown/tan and green) **Fabrics 2 and 3**, and a light for the background (where I use cream) (**Fabric 4**).

Fabric Requirements for exactly as instructed in the mystery - no borders:

Fabric 1 - 2 yards (dark blue)

Fabric 2 - 1-1/4 yards (brown/tan)

Fabric 3 - 7/8 yard (green)

Fabric 4 - 2 yards (cream)

Fabric Requirements if you want to add the 7 borders:

Fabric 1 - 3-3/4 yards (dark blue)

Fabric 2 - 2 yards (brown/tan)

Fabric 3 - 1 yard (green)

Fabric 4 - 2-3/4 yards (cream)
