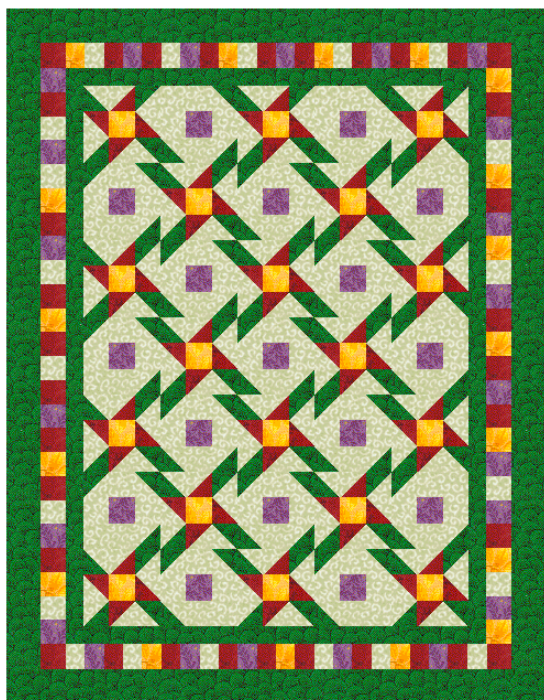

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1:

Cut 7 – 4" strips. Cut these into 65 – 4" squares (A)

Cut 7 – 2-1/2" strips for the inner border (G)

Cut 8 – 4-1/2" strips for the outer border (N)

Fabric 2:

Cut 11 – 4" strips. Cut into 101 – 4" inch squares (B)**

**From the leftovers:

✓ cut 4 – 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles (L)

✓ cut 1 additional 3-1/2" square to add to the 77 you will cut in the next step. (F)

Cut 7 – 3-1/2" strips. Cut these into 77 – 3-1/2" squares.** (F)

Cut 4 – 2" strips for use with the piano key border. (J)

Fabric 3:

Cut 4 – 4" strips. Cut into 36 – 4" squares. (C)**

** From the leftovers of one of these strips, cut 4 – 3-1/2" squares for the border cornerstones.(M)

Cut 4 – 2" strips for use with the piano key border. (K)

Fabric 4:

Cut 2 – 3-1/2” strips. Cut into 18 – 3-1/2” squares. (D)
Cut 4 – 2” strips for use with the piano key border. (H)

Fabric 5:

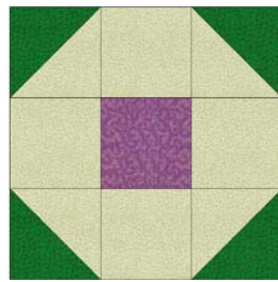
Cut 2 – 3-1/2” strips. Cut into 17 – 3-1/2” squares. (E)
Cut 4 – 2” strips for use with the piano key border. (I)

Block Construction: Blocks are 9” finished – 9-1/2” finished

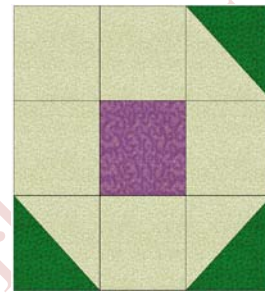
The following Blocks are created:

7 “B” Blocks

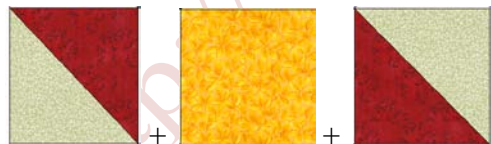
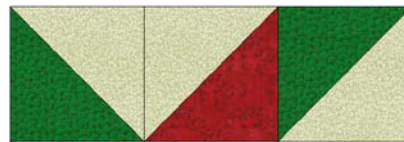


10 “C” Blocks

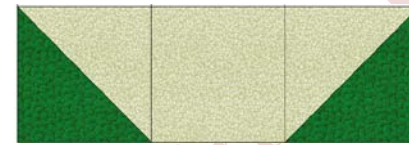
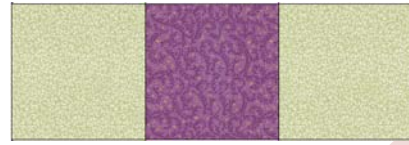
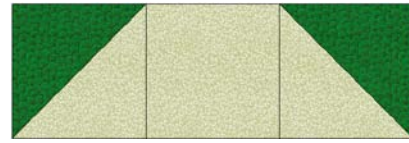
1. Using the 4” squares, construct the following Half Square Triangles. Square them to 3-1/2”:

- 36 Fabric B/C to create 72 HST's.
- 65 Fabric A/B to create 130 HST's.

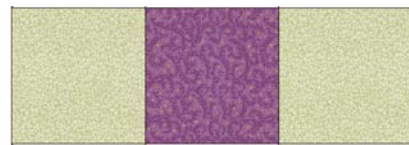
2. Create 18 “A” Blocks



3. Create 7 "B" Blocks:



4. Create 10 "C" Blocks:



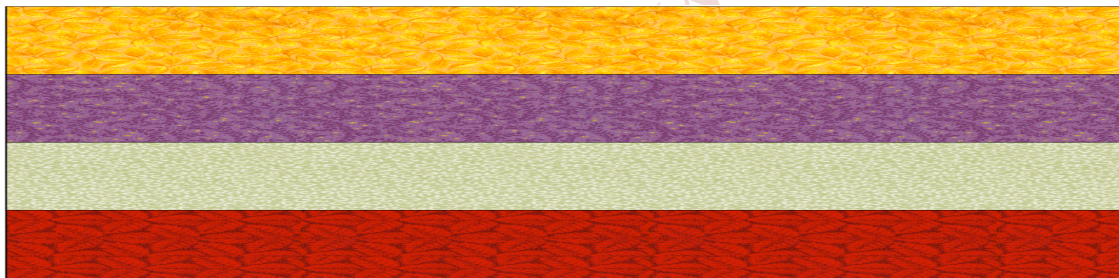
Quilt Assembly and Borders:

5. Set the blocks together as shown below.

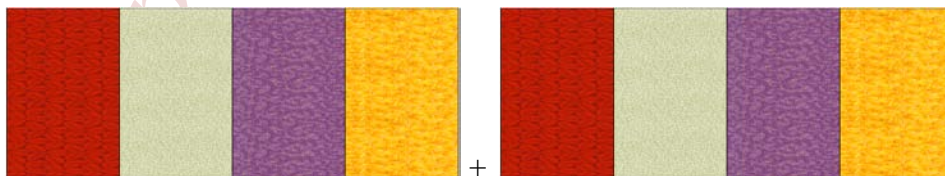
6. Add the 2-1/2" strips of Fabric 1 (G) for the first border. Add the side borders, press the seam allowances toward the border, trim. Add the top and bottom border. Press the seam allowances towards the border and square up.

7. To create the piano key border, sew four sets of the 2" strips (H/I/J/K), pressing the seam allowances toward the darker fabrics. Cut these strips into 38 – 3-1/2" segments.



8. Join 11 segments for the side borders.

9. You will need to add one 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle of Fabric 2 (L) strip to ONE end of each border and you may need to adjust the seams in order to get a perfect fit. Add to the quilt. Press the seam allowance towards the center of the quilt.



10. For the top and bottom borders, you will need 8 segments from Step 7 for each border.. You will also have to add one extra 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle of Fabric 2 (L) to ONE end and you may need to adjust the seams in order to get a perfect fit.

11. Add the 3-1/2" squares of Fabric 3(M).

12. Add the final 4-1/2" border of Fabric 1(N). Be careful not to stretch the piano key border while adding the final border. Add the side borders first. Press the seam allowances towards the outer edges of the quilt. Add the top and bottom borders. Press the seam allowances towards the outer edge of the quilt.



Finishing:

Quilt as desired. Bind with the double fold straight grain binding. Label.
